## Olympic torch relay



A local sporting hero is a step closer to carrying the Olympic flame on its way to London after making it through to the next stage of the nomination process. Royal Club, Coach of the Year, Meg Allen was nominated for the honour last month.

Games chiefs outlined the relay route exactly a year before the torch arrives at Land's End from its base in Olympia, Greece. It will take an 8,000-mile, 70-day tour of the UK, including visits to all the regions. It will be carried for 12 hours a day, coming to a halt at about 6.30pm and reaching Tower Hamlets on Friday 20 July, a week before the opening ceremony.

Meg said: "it was all a bit of a joke to begin with, but I am honoured to be nominated. It would be fantastic to carry the flame - as long as I am allowed to walk."

Meg will find out in this month if she has been successful in being chosen as one of the 8,000 torchbearers needed for the Olympic Torch Relay.

If chosen, we would encourage the curling community to line the streets and cheer her on!

## PVG Scheme



The Royal Club is now fully integrated and is processing new And Up-skilling coaches onto the Protection of Vulnerable Groups disclosure Scheme. Signatories have been recruited and trained for all geographical areas.

All coaches working regularly with vulnerable groups will be required to register - coaches' current disclosures are not transferrable - However this process will be phased in because of the numbers affected, and coaches
